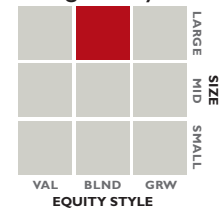

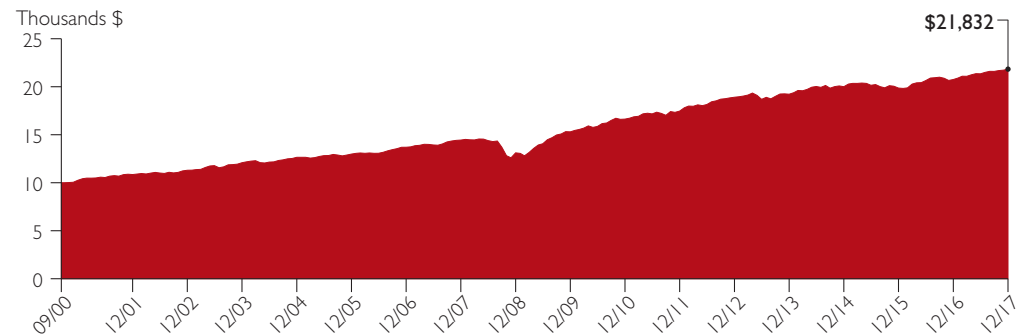

The fund acquired the assets and assumed the liabilities of three Transamerica Partners funds, including Transamerica Partners Institutional Short Horizon (the "predecessor fund"), on May 19, 2017, and the predecessor fund is the accounting and performance survivor of the reorganizations. This means that the predecessor fund's financial and performance history became the financial and performance history of the fund. In the reorganization of the predecessor fund, shareholders of the predecessor fund received Class R4 shares of the fund. The performance of Class R4 shares includes the performance of the predecessor fund prior to the reorganization, and has not been restated to reflect the estimated annual operating expenses of Class R4 shares. Net asset value (NAV) returns include reinvestment of dividends and capital gains but do not reflect the deduction of any sales charges. There are no sales charges for Class R4 shares. Class R shares are available only to eligible retirement plans.

Gross Expense Ratio: 0.83%; Net Expense Ratio: 0.80% (The fee represents the fund's annualized aggregate asset charges based on the fund's investment in underlying funds as disclosed in the current prospectus.) Contractual arrangements have been made with the fund's investment manager, Transamerica Asset Management, Inc. (TAM), through May 1, 2018.
