The Maryland Food Bank: Fighting Hunger for More than 40 Years

The Aegon Transamerica Foundation is proud to support the Maryland Food Bank's mission to feed people, strengthen communities, and end hunger for more Marylanders. In addition to outreach programs that provide direct food assistance, the Maryland Food Bank works tirelessly to stock hundreds of food pantries, soup kitchens, shelters, and other community-based organizations across Maryland.

When it was founded in 1979, the Maryland Food Bank was the first food bank on the East Coast. After more than 40 years of experience, the Maryland Food Bank has become an integral part of Maryland's food assistance structure. The organization intends to continuously expand its impact for as long as hunger persists.

In 2022, Transamerica employees did their part to help Marylanders experiencing food insecurity by participating in the Maryland Food Bank's Pack to Give Back volunteer event. During the event, volunteers helped to feed our neighbors and strengthen our communities by packing holiday meal boxes for local families. With the assistance of community partners like Transamerica, the Maryland Food Bank was able to supply more than 8,600 meal boxes to families in need during the 2022 holiday season.



The 6th Branch: Tapping Volunteer Power to Create More Green Spaces

The 6th Branch and Baltimore Advisory Committee of the Aegon Transamerica Foundation share the same focus: uplifting our community. Founded by a small group of veteran and civilian friends, The 6th Branch is a veteran-led community service organization that serves as stewards for more than 20 acres of green space and provides volunteer and technical support to multiple community groups and schools.

Since The 6th Branch launched, more than 10,000 volunteers have contributed more than 30,000 volunteer hours toward bettering our community. Nearly every day, the nonprofit works to create the community green spaces that our neighborhoods deserve. Volunteers help with basic landscaping tasks, minor demolition, overgrowth removal, trash removal, and more.

In September 2022, Transamerica employees took part in The 6th Branch's 11th annual "Together We Serve 9/11" volunteer event to help create more green space in the city of Baltimore. With volunteer assistance, The 6th Branch transformed vacant lots into safe, inviting spaces for children to play, families to gather and neighbors to assemble. Transamerica proudly served as one of the event's sponsors.
