Boys & Girls Clubs: Empowering Youth

For more than six years, the Denver Committee of the Aegon Transamerica Foundation has provided support for the 20 neighborhood Boys & Girls Clubs in the Denver metropolitan area through financial contributions and volunteer opportunities for Transamerica employees.

The Boys & Girls Clubs of Metro Denver is committed to empowering kids to work together to affect positive change in their neighborhoods and beyond. From Kindergarten through high school, Club members have access to at least 720 hours of programming each year that includes academic support, leadership development, nutrition programming, and more.

Club members also serve as peer mentors, collaborate with community partners, and organize meaningful service projects. The organization's youth-driven leadership programs allow young leaders to take initiative in ways that are meaningful to them, resulting in Club members who consistently demonstrate elevated levels of responsibility.

We are proud to aid the Boys & Girls Clubs of Metro Denver's mission to provide kids with a safe, supportive, fun, and enriching environment that inspires and empowers them to achieve their greatest potential.
